Event Overview

This May Bank Holiday, The Sharks return to Shepperton with an unmissable weekend of racing, community, and riverside energy. The **Shepperton Triple Challenge** brings together **Canoe Slalom (Divisions 3 & 4)** and the **London Regional Wild Water Racing Championships** across three days of racing and development. This is not just a competition — it's a chance to train, test yourself, and grow alongside paddlers of all levels.

Whether you're chasing a personal best, racing for the first time, or trying a new discipline — this weekend is about **confidence**, **connection**, **and challenge**. With coached sessions, supportive guidance, and a welcoming riverside atmosphere, paddlers are encouraged to step up, switch it up, and paddle with purpose.

To make the most of the long weekend, **free riverside camping** is available from Friday to Monday. It's a brilliant opportunity to paddle more, relax by the water, and share the weekend with club-mates, family, and new friends.

With slalom runs, team events, Wild Water Racing sprints, and classic races all on offer, paddlers will have multiple chances to develop skills, compete, and most importantly — have a blast on the water.

Get ready to charge the gates and ride the river!

Saturday 24th May – Slalom Training & Classic River Race

Kick off the weekend by building technique, control, and confidence on the water.

Morning – Coached Slalom Sessions | 11:00am–2:00pm

The slalom course will come alive with structured, supportive coaching sessions tailored for new and developing paddlers. These sessions will be split into groups, with participants encouraged to explore **all disciplines**:

- Master the gates in **K1**
- Step up the challenge in C1
- Grab a partner (or rival!) and take on the **ultimate C2 course**

Whether you're new to the water or refining race-day skills, these sessions focus on **building** confidence and exploring the thrill of slalom racing.

Afternoon – Classic River Race | 3:00pm Start

Part of the London Regional Wild Water Racing Championships, the Classic takes paddlers on a fast-flowing 3km stretch from Shepperton Weir to the downstream bridge. The river offers great variety, moving water, and a chance to put fitness and control to the test.



C2 Wild Water Racers welcome – and encouraged – and if you haven't raced one before, this is your chance to try! It's fast, it's exciting, and it's a brilliant experience. Grab your teammates, rally your club, and get ready for some Wild Water **ACTION!**



The London Regional Sprint WWR Championships kicks off with an approximately 200m course. Paddlers can take as many runs as they want, with the best two counting toward the rankings. All boats are welcome to participate; however, only those who confirm WWR rules, will be included in the rankings
